

# Death Valley National Park

## Day Trip from Las Vegas, NV

Round Trip is 8.5 hours total - with NO stopping. With stops at the sites in DVNP and Rhyolite, NV we recommend 12-14 hours total. We also recommend departing Las Vegas 2 hours prior to sunrise, if heading there between April-October, due to high temps in DVNP.

### Places to See

- Start: Las Vegas, Nevada
  - Drive through Pahrump, NV (on NV-160)
  - To Shoshone, CA (via NV-372 / CA-178)
  - Into Death Valley NP on CA-178
  - From Central Las Vegas to Badwater Basin (inside DVNP) is approximately 3 hours
- Badwater Basin
- Artist's Palette Way (Loop Drive)
- Zabriskie's Point
- Twenty Mule Team Loop
- Furnace Creek (NPS Visitor Center / Passport Stamp)
- Stovepipe Wells (NPS Passport Stamp)
- Ubehebe Crater
- Depart DVNP on Daylight Pass Rd, towards Beatty, NV, onto NV-374.
- Rhyolite Ruins (Ghost Town) & Goldwell Outdoors Art Museum (located together off NV-374 before entering Beatty, NV)
- Return to Las Vegas via NV-95

### Must Pack Items!

- Sunblock; Sunscreen
- A hat
- Plenty of Water - a gallon per person is recommended
- A Physical Map of DVNP - phone signals are sparse
- Fill your gas tank in Pahrump - gas is VERY expensive in DVNP
